Grades Pre-K to 8

Grades Pre-K to 2

The Students will:

1. Identify basic shapes
2. Develop observation skills
3. Color within a measured space
4. Use art room supplies properly (scissors, crayons, paintbrushes, magic markers, cray pas, etc.)

Grades 3 to 5

The Students will:

1. Identify primary, secondary and tertiary colors
2. Learn to mix colors
3. Discover tonal values
4. Use observation skills
5. Observe vanishing point and develop depth perception

Grades 6 to 8

The Students will:

1. Prepare negative and positive placement
2. Prepare tessellations – beginner stage
3. Create grids for tessellations
4. Reinforce and create skills in the different art movements
5. Study Art History (artists)
6. Develop drawing skills (shading)
7. Discover source of light and shadow values on a subject

Along with lessons, all grades are encouraged to use creativity in all the lessons planned

If a student excels in any of the lessons, an advanced skill may be offered
