As enrollment allows, admission is also granted to non-Catholics whose parents endorse the mission of our school.

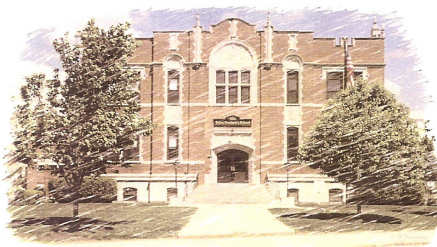
